We are looking for a **full-time Pastor of Discipleship and Family Ministries** to join our team and shepherd our congregation, with a focus on discipleship across all ages, and special attention to supporting families, children, youth, and young adults.

About the Role

The Pastor of Discipleship and Family Ministries will:

- Provide spiritual leadership and discipleship pathways for all ages within the church.
- Lead, develop, and support **small groups and discipleship initiatives** that encourage spiritual growth and community connection.
- Oversee and equip **children's ministry, youth ministry, and young adults**, building teams of volunteers and fostering a safe, welcoming environment for families.
- Provide **discipleship and support for parents and families**, equipping them to nurture faith at home and within the church community.
- Work collaboratively with lead pastor, elders, deacons, staff, and volunteers to pursue the mission of Hope City in our local context.

Key Responsibilities

- Discipleship and Teaching:
 - Create and implement a discipleship strategy across age groups.
 - Facilitate small groups, train leaders, initiate Bible studies, and mentorship relationships.
 - o Preach and/or teach 1-2 times/month.

• Family and Next Generation Ministry:

- Lead and coordinate children's ministry, ensuring a safe, engaging environment.
- Build and support youth ministry programs and connection points.
- Develop ministry opportunities for young adults to grow in faith and community.
- Support and equip parents and caregivers to disciple their children and youth.

Pastoral Leadership:

- o Provide pastoral care, counselling, and visitation as needed.
- Assist in planning and leading church events.

• Volunteer Development:

 Recruit, train, and support volunteers for children's, youth, and young adult ministries.

Qualifications

- A growing, vibrant relationship with Jesus Christ.
- A clear sense of calling to pastoral ministry and discipleship.
- Experience working with families, children, youth, or young adults in a church or ministry context.
- Strong relational and communication skills.
- Demonstrates initiative as as self-starter, proactive in identifying needs, anticipate challenges, and taking action as necessary.
- Ability to work collaboratively with a team in a small-church setting.
- Formal theological education (degree or diploma) is preferred but not required if balanced by ministry experience.
- Agreement with the mission, vision, and theological positions of Hope City Church.

Compensation

This is a **full-time**, **salaried position**. Salary and benefits will be commensurate with education and experience, within the means of our denomination (Evangelical Free Church of Canada) and church context.
