

Director/Pastor of Youth Ministry (Part-Time 8-10 hrs/week)

Hope City Church is a welcoming community of approximately 120 people, seeking to live out our mission to love God, love people, and make disciples. We are looking for a **part-time Director/Pastor of Youth Ministry** to join our team to lead and oversee Youth Ministry, comprised of Junior Youth (Grade 6-8) and Senior Youth (Grade 9-12).

About the Role

The Director of Youth Ministry will:

- Plan and lead bi-weekly Friday gatherings with volunteer team (activities and Bible studies)
- Choose, plan, and teach Sunday morning curriculum with team of volunteers
- Recruit, screen, schedule, train, and develop new volunteers (have 2 meetings annually with the team)
- Conduct annual ministry evaluations with volunteers
- Organize and oversee details for special events (outreach and retreats)
- Help graduating youth transition to young adults ministry
- Ensure a safe and nurturing environment for both teachers and children, in alignment with Hope City's Child Protection Policy, including maintaining current criminal record checks for all volunteers
- Participate in staff meetings once a week for ministry updates and collaboration
- Participate in leadership meetings once a month
- Communicate consistently with parents about programming, youth development, and upcoming events
- Develop relationships with the youth, mentoring and guiding them in their faith
- Communicate consistently with parents about programming, youth's development, and upcoming events, offering support in their role in spiritual development
- Manage Youth ministry budget and other Youth ministry related administrative tasks

 Work collaboratively with lead pastor, elders, deacons, staff, and volunteers to pursue the mission of Hope City in our local context

Qualifications

- A growing, vibrant relationship with Jesus Christ.
- A clear sense of calling to youth ministry and discipleship.
- Experience working with youth and families in a church or ministry context.
- Strong relational and communication skills.
- Demonstrates initiative as as self-starter, proactive in identifying needs, anticipate challenges, and taking action as necessary.
- Ability to work collaboratively with a team in a small-church setting.
- Formal theological education (degree or diploma) is preferred but not required if balanced by ministry experience.
- Agreement with the mission, vision, and theological positions of Hope City Church
- Criminal Record Check required if hired

Compensation

This is a **part-time role (8–10 hours/week)**. Compensation will be provided as **hourly pay**, based on experience and qualifications, and in alignment with our church's budget and the Evangelical Free Church of Canada guidelines.

- **Hourly Rate:** \$20–\$35/hr, commensurate with experience and education
- Vacation: 4% vacation pay in lieu, as per BC Employment Standards
- Benefits: This position does not include extended health or dental benefits due to its part-time nature

Note: This position may be combined with the Director of Youth Ministry role.
